THE CHAIR: MARVIN ROBINSON

Marvin joined Council in 2017 and is extremely proud to be assuming the position of ESFA Chair for season 2023-24.

Growing up in Wolverhampton, Marvin attended Wolverhampton Grammar School (WGS) where his love of school sport was developed and nurtured by a few of his teaching heroes in Peter Hills, Tim Browning, John Johnson, and Theo King, teachers who, like many others, shared great knowledge and went above and beyond for their students.

During his school years, Marvin lived a full life of football, representing his School, Wolverhampton Primary Schools' FA, Wolverhampton Schools' FA, West Midlands County Schools' FA, and in 1997 England U18 Schoolboys.

Throughout the years, Marvin experienced and won many ESFA competitions such as the ESFA Under 19 Inter County Cup Final, played at Villa Park, as well as the ISFA Under 18 National Sixes in 1996.

On a trip to France, organised by new ESFA Vice Chair Nick Loftus, Wolverhampton Schools' FA reached the final of the 1996 Eurofoot Tournament. Marvin was voted 'Meilleur Buteur' (Best Goal Scorer) and picked to play in a European Select XI; this experience had an everlasting impact.

Combining his A-levels with training at Derby County FC, he then went on to win the SAFIB Centenary Shield in 1997, beating Switzerland in the final.

After completing his A-levels Marvin went onto a professional career in football, making his debut for Derby County versus Arsenal, at Highbury, in 1999 and his full debut versus Manchester United later in the same year.

A double leg fracture suffered on loan at Stoke City FC, home of many ESFA National Cup Finals, cut short a promising career. After stints at Tranmere, Chesterfield, Walsall, Lincoln, Oxford and Cambridge amongst others, another broken leg forced Marvin to return to education.

Marvin obtained a BA (Hons) degree in Visual Communication from the University of Wolverhampton, a Football Marketing and Management certification from the Sports Business Institute Barcelona and then a MSc in Sporting Directorship from the University of Salford, whilst also training in Sports Governance.

He holds a variety of roles within the football ecosystem - FA Council Rep, UEFA Match Delegate, Premier League Match Delegate, GBE Exception Panel Member - FA, Specialist Arbitrator - FA, Specialist Arbitrator - Sport Resolutions and National Safeguarding Panel - Sport Resolutions - all with the purpose of diversifying and governing the game and ensuring participation opportunities for young people.

Marvin's involvement in schools' football and the profound impact it has had on him, through both lived experiences and life-long relationships with teaching mentors served as the fuel that led him back to the ESFA in 2017.

During his time on Council, Marvin has served on a range of sub-committees including Representative, Governance, Development and PR and Marketing.

Marvin has particularly enjoyed the international friendship and learning opportunities from touring with national squads and from hosting colleagues from other countries. He recognises the fortunate position he is in, to both empathise and witness the growth of individuals, not just players, through all aspects of participation (such as trials). Similarly, the excitement of whole schools, involved in national competitions and especially finals, which serve as a reminder of his own school bringing two coaches full of pupils to watch a nail-biting final group fixture, in the Centenary Shield, at Rushden and Diamonds' Nene Park.

Away from work, Marvin is extremely grateful for the support of his partner and three children throughout his schools' footballing journey. His eldest daughter regularly competes in several sports, including athletics and netball, and his youngest daughter was recently crowned League Champion and Girls' City Champion, scoring in the final, at the Wolverhampton Schools' FA awards evening. Like most parents, Marvin's day job is family taxi driver, although the perks of this allow him to see his children grow up enjoying all the benefits that sport offers.

Marvin is a 'Vis Comm' enthusiast and recently has acted as both panel member and mentor for REFRAME - an ambitious partnership by Apple and the Southbank Centre that supports emerging black creatives in the UK. The programme has two key components; Inspire Schools - a project for 21 secondary schools to spark a passion for creativity among the next generation of talent and The Residency - an intensive, industry-led training and development programme for 80 emerging creatives aged 18+ looking to develop their skills in music, photography and film-making.

Marvin is incredibly proud of his involvement with the ESFA and never more so than now as Chair for the season 2023-24. He takes the honour extremely seriously and is determined to ensure that every student can play schools' football in a safe, inclusive environment while being supported in developing not only their talent but also their values such as leadership, honesty, and integrity, as well as their own character traits such as effort, determination, and perseverance. Key life skills that are honed through school sport, in what is an ever-changing, demanding world.

Marvin pays tribute to the teachers and adults who work so tirelessly within schools' football for the benefit of young people and is looking forward to exciting and challenging times ahead for the ESFA. He hopes to make many new friends on his travels as Chair this season.
